

<u>10 minutes without electricity</u>

- All the electrical appliances such as fans, light bulbs, computers etc.in the school are switched off for 10 minutes every day from 9:00 a.m. to 9:10 a.m.
- This approach has been adopted to inculcate in the students, teachers and staff the importance of using electricity wisely and saving it for the future.

Eco friendly dustbins

- Separate colour coded dustbins have been provided for everyone to dispose of papers, newspapers and non-biodegradable waste in the school campus.
- The students are thus able to distinguish between different kinds of waste materials and dispose of them accordingly. The importance of the same is also imbibed simultaneously.

Steel tiffin's and water bottles

- The students bring lunch boxes and water bottles made of stainless steel instead of plastic.
- They also use reusable food containers, drinking containers, utensils (spoons and forks) and napkins instead of pre-packaged foods, plastic bags, juice boxes, pouches, paper napkins and disposable utensils.
- This way they are guided to make smart environmental as well as health choices.
- It helps to inculcate in them the importance of caring for plants and using organic methods for growing plants.

Use of newspaper bags for gifts

- Newspapers are re-used in the form of gift bags that are used to present gifts to guests for most of the events and visits.
- It helps to reduce the usage of gift bags made of fancy papers which are not eco-friendly.
- These gift bags are made by the students during their work education

classes.

Diya decoration using earthen lamps

- The students are guided by the teachers to make earthen lamps or diyas which are later given to the needy people on the auspicious occasion of Diwali.
- It promotes the usage of eco-friendly resources in place of electric lights.
- Avoiding the usage of electricity also saves economic resources.

Models on global warming and Science exhibition

- Students made innovative models to demonstrate the causes and effects of global warming which were displayed in the science exhibition and witnessed by the entire school.
- The focus of the science exhibition 2022 was to save the environment.
- Students presented various innovative models on organic farming and agriculture based on cost effective ways on rain water harvesting.
- It was a great way to reinforce their understanding about pollution and waste management along with sustainability methods.
- We have also banned the use of thermocol for any art and craft purposes.
- We always encourage students to use eco-friendly materials or reuse old things for art and craft work.

Innovations

- Meeting of coordinators with the principal is organized in order to explain the methodology or techniques of teaching to students at different levels.
- Department meetings organized by the coordinators on the last working day of every month and after every exam to solve the problems in teaching of their respective subjects at various levels.
- Class tests are conducted by all subject teachers after completion of each lesson.
- Written revision tests are conducted at least one week prior to each unit test or exam for each class or section.
- Adoption of every two children by the teachers of board classes.
- A word for a week is written on the board. Its meaning is explained to students. Thus a word is learnt to be used by students as and when required while speaking or writing.
- Suggestion box is placed in the school in order to ascertain the problems or suggestions related to teaching or learning.
- Reward to outstanding students in sports and academics.
- Reward in recognition of improvement in performance in academics.
- Innovative or creative envelopes made by teachers to give away report cards in an attractive manner.

In Testing or Evaluations

- Timely completion of the syllabus of each term followed by correction of all notebooks is being monitored.
- Day to day progress of the child is noted by class teachers and any remarkable change is noted and informed to the parents on Parents- teacher meets along with the answer sheets of exams conducted.
- Besides the evaluation, class or revision test is conducted for regular practice.
- Discipline squad houses mainly of students of different classes have been made operational.
